RECESS Letter to EdUS & EGSS

Student Letter to EdUS & EGSS.pdf

- Radical Educators Cultivating Equitable & Sustainable Spaces (RECESS) has authored and circulated an open letter addressed to EdUS and EGSS.
 - "Radical Educators Cultivating Equitable & Sustainable Spaces (RECESS) is a collective of preservice teachers, working schoolteachers, educational researchers, community educators and community members who meet on a

monthly basis to discuss critical frameworks for anti-oppressive pedagogy and their applications in educational spaces." (<u>Source: Join RECESS Sign Up Form</u>)

- At the end of the letter, there is a list of five demands:
 - "We demand that EGSS and EdUS release statements clearly stating their stance against the genocide of Palestinians in Gaza and the West Bank, express support for Palestinians' right to return, which is clearly outlined in UN G.A. resolution 194, and acknowledging that the Palestinian struggle is one of Indigenous resistance to settler-colonial rule – a struggle which our faculty and students unions routinely claim to support."
 - 2. "We demand that EGSS and EdUS develop mental health resources with the express purpose of supporting Palestinian and Arab students in the Faculty of Education."
 - 3. "We demand that EGSS and EdUS open a council in which both associations investigate McGill's position of complicity within settler-colonialism of Palestine and the Faculty of Education's plans to move forward with the building of the new facility of the Sylvan Adams Sports Science Institute."
 - 4. "We demand that EGSS and EdUS create and endorse upcoming actions at McGill, and across Montreal, which support basic Palestinian human rights."
 - 5. "We demand that EGSS and EdUS open a council meeting to vote on boycotting products that are complicit in genocide, particularly through Boycott, Divestment, Sanctions (BDS) initiatives."
- The EdUS executives have organized a response plan.
 - 1. We release a statement that umbrellas 3 demands (Demands 1, 2 & 4)
 - a. Condemn Antisemitism and Islamophobia
 - i. We can release a statement, but if McGill catches wind and accuses us of violating our MOA, we will need to rescind our statement.
 - ii. To minimise liability, the statement will need to be neutral.
 - b. Provide internal and external resources for students (within McGill/Education and within MTL in general)
 - i. VP Wellness is compiling a list of resources for students.



- ii. <u>Faith-based Group Support for Jewish-identified Students | Office</u> <u>of Religious and Spiritual Life - McGill University</u>
- iii. MORSL faith-based group support for Muslim-identified students | Office of Religious and Spiritual Life - McGill University
- c. Clarification for certain demands by RECESS
- d. REQUIRES A VOTE (75% IN FAVOUR)
- 2. (Demand 3) We suggest for students to find other outlets since it's out of our reach. We simply do not have access to this kind of information.
- 3. Demand 5 requires clarification by RECESS.
 - a. Creating a council/committee to vote on boycotts vs. holding a public EdUS meeting where the Council votes on boycotts?
- RECESS expressed that they're open to collaboration. Additionally, please do not directly message any individuals present in the signatures regarding this open letter. Any communication regarding this will be sent to the RECESS Collective email address.
