Merch

- We ask that when you send us your graphic you send the editable link on canva instead of only the image. We just want to double check for mistakes or make slight changes, if needed.
- Don't forget to include a caption for your instagram post, **this includes required links for events/posts**
- Most of us have group chats with all of you, so please send your requests there or make a groupchat with the both of us if you need something.
- We try to post your events as soon as possible but if we already have multiple scheduled posts for the day/week, there might be a delay so that we're not clogging the feed every day
 - Send your events as soon as possible so that you have a lot of time to promote them!
- As we know, pretty much every exec on council is on FE3 at the moment. This is going to be a little bit of a challenge in terms of posting pictures from events. We might approach some reps to take pictures/post on the IG if we are not available
